This year will mark the eighth annual SCVi Multicultural Feast, a day-long celebration in which families join the students on campus to share food, learn from each other what their cultural t and share their own.

This year, each grade level has chosen a country they will focus upon. On the day of the celebration, learners and their families will take turns presenting to their peers and guests what the learned about the culture of the country they studied as well as sharing something delicious to eat.
