Catalina Island Marine Institute (CIMI) at Cherry Cove is a unique outdoor science school, providing an exciting outdoor educational experience for students from public and private schools. It is one of three outdoor science schools on Catalina Island operated by the nonprofit corporation, Guided Discoveries.

Located just under two miles from the town of Two Harbors, CIMI at Cherry Cove is an ideal site for outdoor education. Originally built in the 1920's as a private camp facility, Cherry Cove boasts an ideal combination of attributes for the educational camp experience. The campus features comfortable platform tents situated in a large natural grove of native cherry trees and a large indoor dining hall. Additionally the site contains open-air laboratories, classrooms, aquariums, display areas and recreational facilities that are well integrated with the natural beauty of Catalina's land and sea environment.

The focus is on hands-on experiential science, utilizing state-of-the-art labs and equipment, increases science literacy and environmental stewardship. CIMI's expert instructors guide students through island terrestrial biology, marine biology labs and field activities designed to stimulate minds, build character, develop social skills, and most importantly, create excitement about science. During our three- and five-day programs, students and teachers participate in a variety of hands-on labs and field activities.
