A Scoop of Flavor: Pumpkin Lasagna

Ingredients

- 1/2 c. (1 stick) butter.
- 4 cloves of garlic.
- 1 onion, chopped.
- 1 tsp. cider vinegar.
- 1 tsp dried sage.
- 3 (15-oz) cans of pumpkin puree.
- 2 tbsp maple syrup, 1 tsp freshly grated nutmeg.
- 1 tsp freshly grated nutmeg
- Kosher salt
- freshly ground black pepper
- 1 (15-oz) container ricotta cheese
- 3 c. shredded mozzarella, divided
- 3 c. shredded Fontina, divided
- 1 egg, beaten.
- cooking spray for baking dish
- box no-boil lasagna noodles

Preheat the oven to 375°. In a saucepan over medium heat melt butter. Add garlic and onion and cook until fragrant and soft, about 5 minutes. Deglaze pan with vinegar and cook until mostly evaporated, about 4 minutes. Stir in sage.

Add pumpkin, maple syrup, and nutmeg and season with salt and pepper. Heat until warmed through, about 5 minutes. In a medium bowl, stir together ricotta, 2 cups mozzarella, 2 cups Fontina, and egg until combined. Grease a 9"-x-13" baking dish (or similarly sized dish) with cooking spray. Smear a thin layer of pumpkin mixture on the bottom of the baking dish and cover the mixture with noodles. Add a third of pumpkin mixture followed by a third of cheese mixture. Repeat two more times, using all pumpkin and cheese. Top with a layer of noodles. Sprinkle with remaining 1 cup mozzarella and 1 cup Fontina. Bake lasagna, covered, 35 minutes. Uncover, increase heat to 400°, and cook until the cheese on top has melted, about 15 minutes more.



Adding chocolate chips to a traditional apple pie is the literal best. An outburst of flavors exploding in your mouth, the sweet melted chocolate with the added crunch and taste of the apple just has a godly attitude against your taste buds.

Scones! There's a good example of fall foods! For those of you that don't know what a scone is, well let me delight you! A scone is a fall dessert, usually made of either wheat or oatmeal. A scone has a gingerbread-like texture with a great crunch. It smells like cinnamon and pumpkin, but I honestly did not like the Pumpkin scone from Starbucks. For me a dessert/pastry should have a sauce to add flavor and the scone just doesn't.

Still on the Starbucks scene, I'm going to talk about the pumpkin spice latte (Italian chef kiss). This drink is just scrumptious. I love it with all my soul and brains. It is the most amazing Starbucks drink to ever exist. I don't particularly like coffee, but this drink is from another world. 


Hellraiser- Oct 7, 2022
