2. What is ELAC?

*The English Language Advisory Committee (ELAC) was created to keep families of EL learners informed and updated on how we are supporting them in school and to build relationships with the learners and their parents.*

3. ESSER III and COVID Prevention Plans

*SCVi has received Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds under the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act. They are required to develop a plan for how they will use ESSER III funds to, at a minimum, address learners' academic, social,*

*emotional, and mental health needs, as well as the opportunity gaps that existed before, and were exacerbated by, the COVID-19 pandemic.*

*SCVi received \$448,924 in ESSER III funds, and they plan to allocate the money towards staffing needs, technology, school equipment, safety/repairs, curriculum and social-emotional well-being. The plan must be adopted by their local governing board at a public meeting on or before October 29, 2021 and must be submitted for review and approval to the authorizer and County Office of Education within five days of adoption.*
